## Coffee

Like chocolate, coffee is a stimulant thanks to the caffeine. The ancients considered it a sacred beverage that was served sparingly and only on rare occasions. Modern Italians also consider it a sacred drink, but consume it in large quantities.

### Espresso:

A syrupy shot of coffee with thick body and persistent taste thanks to the way the beans are roasted. Must be served piping hot.

### Cappuccino:

A shot of espresso with frothy milk served in either a cup or glass.

### Caffee Americano:

Coffee lighter in colour and served in a larger cup.

### Caffee Macchiato:

Espresso that is stained with a bit of milk, making it easier to go down.

## Rome – Day tours

### Rome – Florence

Depart for Florence driving through the beautiful countryside of Latium, Umbria and Tuscany. Upon arrival in Florence a guided tour of the city centre including the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, Giotto's Bell Tower and Baptistry and the statue of David by Michelangelo. After lunch there will be time for some shopping before departing for Rome. Arrival in Rome approx 8.30p.m.

### Rome – Naples – Pompeii

Depart along the 'Autostrada del Sole' for Naples. Upon arrival guided tour of the city including Mergellina, Lungomare Caracciolo, Castel dell'Ovo, Church of San Francesco di Paolo, the San Carlo Theatre, Galleria Umberto 1 and the harbour. Continue to Pompeii and after lunch enjoy a tour of the well-preserved ruins of the ancient Roman city destroyed by the eruption of Mt. Vesuvius in 79 A.D. Depart for Rome approx 5.30p.m. arriving at 9.30 p.m.

### Rome – Naples – Capri

Depart for Naples and upon arrival transfer to Capri. Weather permitting visit the Blue Grotto. Return to Marina Grande and depart by minibus for a tour of the island ending at Anacapri. After lunch in a local restaurant there will be free time to explore the island or do some shopping. Depart for Rome approx 5.30pm. arriving at 9.30p.m.

### Rome – Assisi – Orvieto

Depart for Assisi driving through the medieval towns of Spoleto, Trevi, Foligno and Spello. Upon arrival in Assisi, visit St. Francis Basilica and the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli. Afternoon visit to Orvieto to view the renown cathedral.

## Florence – Day tours

### Florence – Siena – San Gimignano

Depart for Siena driving through the ever-changing scenery of the Chianti area. Upon arriving in Siena, guided tour of the old city centre and the Piazza del Campo. Time for lunch (not included) before departing for San Gimignano, famous for its numerous towers, frescoes and other art treasures.

### Florence – Pisa

A half-day excursion to Pisa. Guided visit of Piazza dei Miracoli, the Leaning Tower, the Baptistry and the Cathedral.

## Milan – Day tours

### Milan – Lake Como – Bellagio

Visit Como and take a boat ride on the lake to admire some of the magnificent villas.

### Milan – Verona – Lake Garda

Visit the romantic city of Romeo and Juliet and the famous arena. After lunch continue to Sirmione to take in a beautiful view of Lake Garda..
